"A Shot of the Ecosystem" Photo-taking Competition 2015

Task Description and Suggested Marking Criteria

<u>Task:</u> Visit the HK Wetland Park, take a photo which you think can reflect the uniqueness of HK's ecosystem. Using a Chinese or English description of 200-250 words, describe how your photo matches the theme. Please also give your photo a title and fill in other information in the sheet..

Guided Questions for your photo/ description:

- 1) What and how are the activities of the species related to ecology? Or, how do the species you captured in the photo reveal their interactions with the environment?
- 2) Is there any ecological relationship between different organisms you captured in the photo?
- 3) How can this photo reflect the special characteristics of HK's ecosystem?
- 4) Why is this characteristic special in HK and not easily found in other places?
- 5) Any other points you think is applicable to put in the description.

Note: Participants are free to decide what photos to take and the contents of the description, e.g. the photo is not restricted to only having either plants or animals, but they can be a combination of both, i.e. they can take a photo with a crab and mangrove and discuss their ecological relationship. The above guidance questions are just a reference.
